■ Important

- Drive at a slow speed in all areas of park.
- Observe quiet times (late night/early morning) and do not disturb other tenants.
- Always extinguish fires completely when leaving them for any amount of time. Place remaining charcoal ash in provided ash-garbage.
- Sewage disposal is located on the park trail behind the trees near the main entrance. (See the park map)
- All garbage and food items must be contained within your tent or lodge or RV at night. Garbage will attract wild animals you may not want around the campsite.
- Do not build a fire directly on the ground. Use provided blocks in each camp site/lodge.
- KARAOKE machines and generators are not permitted.
- Please do not park or drive through the grass.



■ Garbage



Please dispose of all garbage properly according the rules.

Year by year there has been an increase in the number of campers who dispose of garbage improperly.

If there is no improvement in this situation by the end of the season, then next year we may have to charge for garbage pickups or ask visitors to take their garbage with them when they leave.

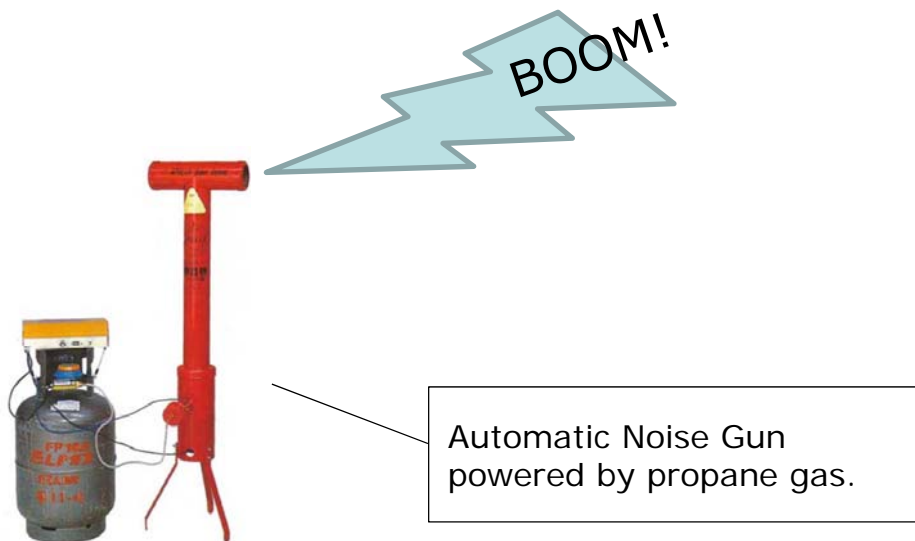


■ Noise Guns (deer scarer: *shika odoshi*)

We appreciate your understanding, and sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

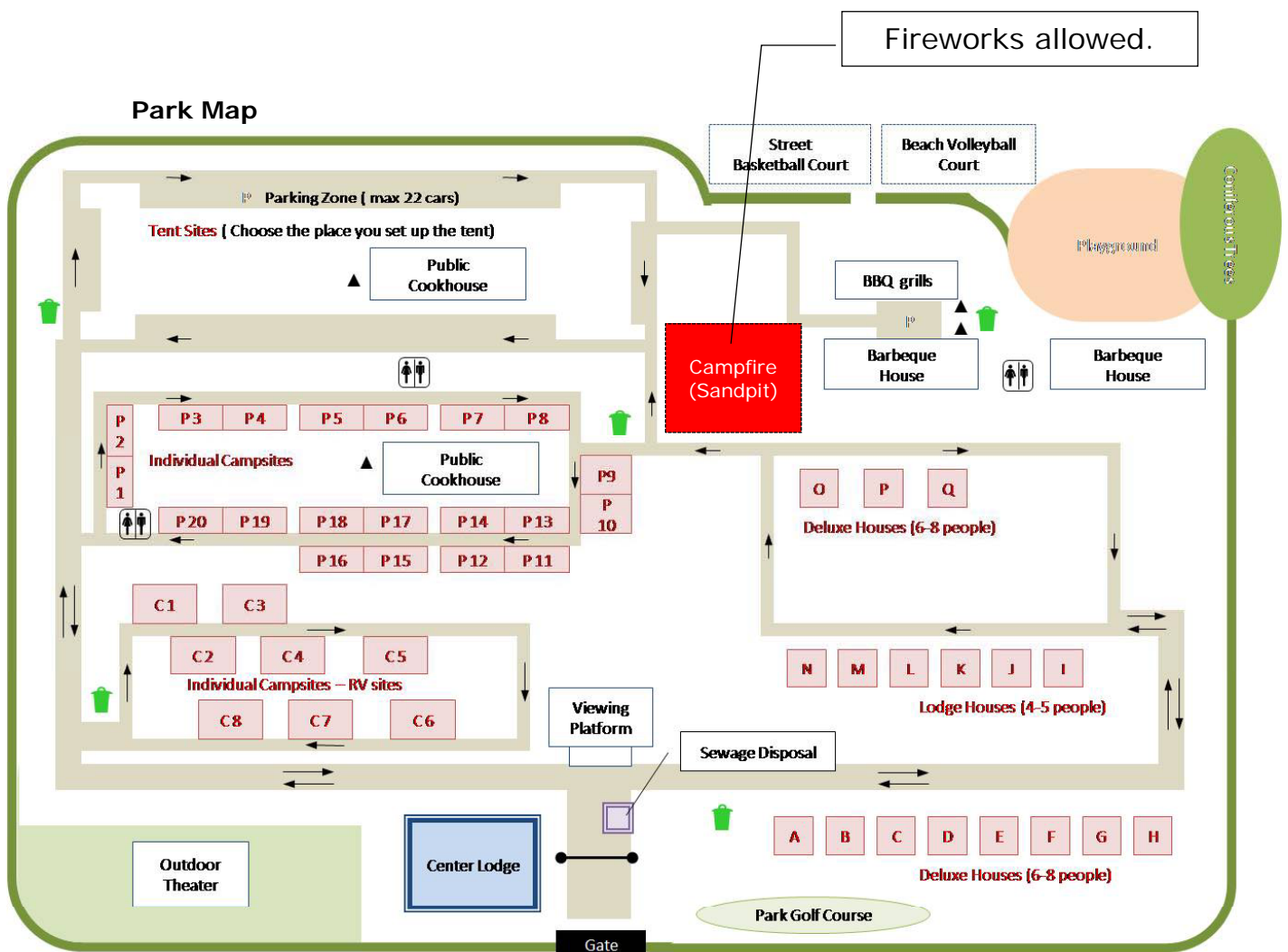


■ Fireworks

- Firework ashes should be placed only in the provided ash garbage.

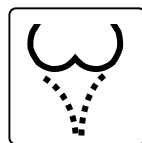
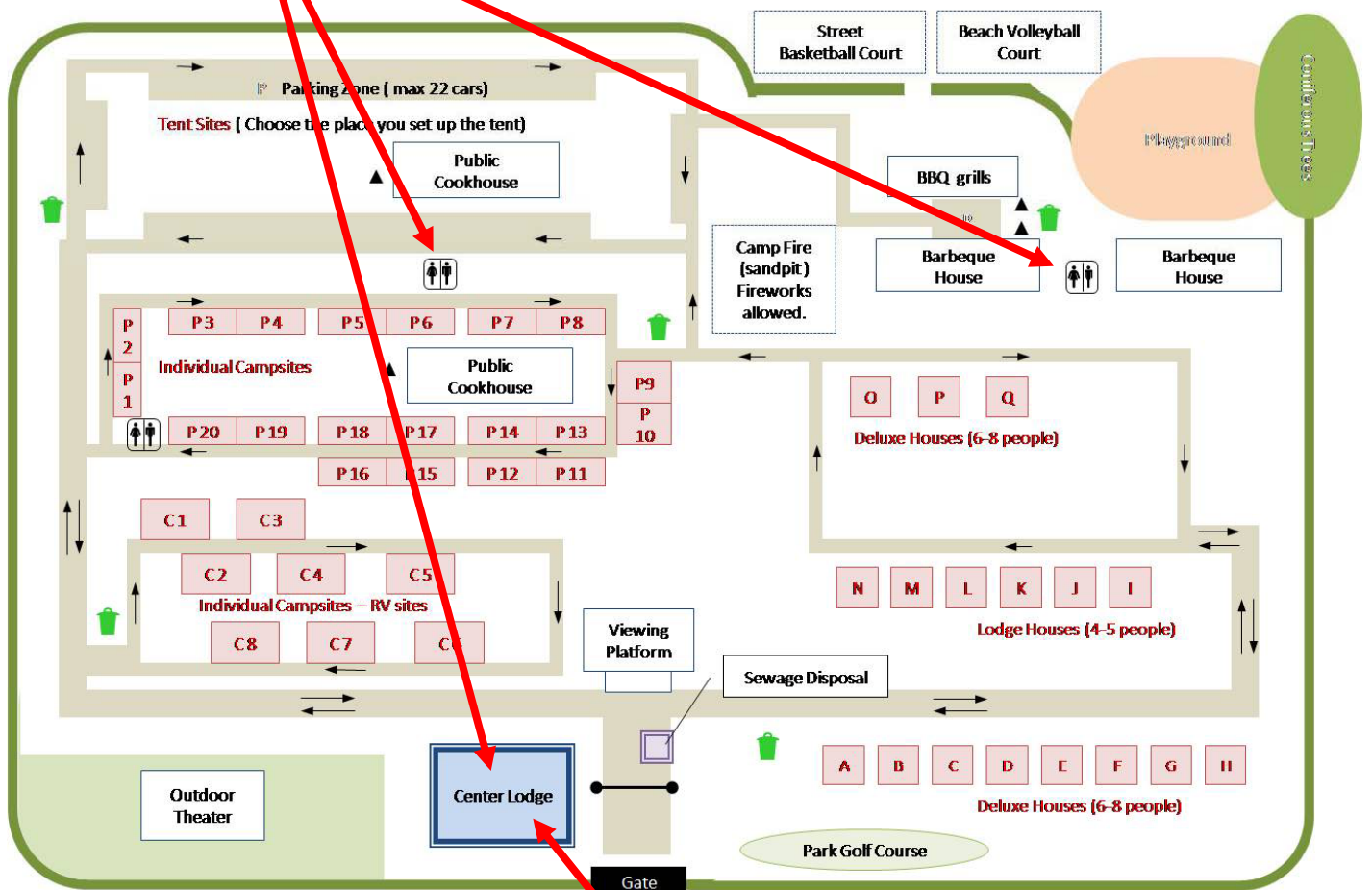
